**Supervisor's Report:**

**Supervisor Vegliante stated:** "Thank you everyone, I encourage everyone to be ready tomorrow we are expecting a pretty substantial snow storm somewhere between 5 to 10 inches of snow. The snow is supposed to start in the morning continue throughout the day and into Wednesday morning based on the length of time and duration of the storm and the fact we are expecting significant accumulation I encourage people to do your shopping tonight if possible. Do not travel on the roads during the storm event and let our town crew work as well as they can and let our crew the roads as soon as possible. Being that it is spread over 26 hours there will be time when our crew will take breaks, there will be time when our roads will be hazardous. That being said many of you may have recognized the ongoing dangerous condition in the Foxcroft community. We will be monitoring that situation as well we had to go in and spread ice control material some sand and salt. When we were in there we saw the icing condition was pretty substantial. We will be monitoring the snow removal tomorrow and if necessary we will take action just to make sure people can access their houses and the emergency service workers can get in and out of the complex as necessary. It is an action that we do not like to do but we were forced to do due to the management's neglect of their property and their responsibility to provide a safe community."


