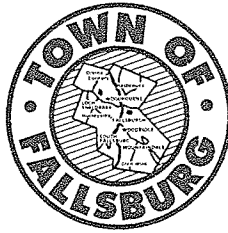


Motion by Councilman Weiner & Mayor Collins and seconded by Councilman Steingart & Trustee Kates to open the Public Hearing.





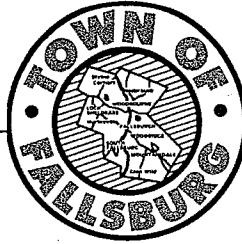

TOWN OF MOUNTAINDALE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT UPGRADE PROJECT

INTENT TO DECLARE LEAD AGENCY UNDER SEQRA

**WHEREAS** the Town of Fallsburg, Sullivan County, New York (hereinafter the "Town") has established the public benefit to the Town residents of the upgrade construction of an existing Wastewater Treatment Plant in the hamlet of Mountaindale (hereinafter the "WWTP"); and

**WHEREAS** the proposed WWTP project is needed to ensure the public safety and protect surface waters and the environment; and

**WHEREAS** the Town has conducted various studies of the condition of the system and the means for improvements; and

**WHEREAS** the action of designing and constructing a new WWTP is a Type I Action under the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) and must be treated as a Type I Action due to requirements of the NYS Clean Water State Revolving Loan Fund; and

**WHEREAS** Part I of the Long Environmental Assessment Form (hereinafter "EAF") has been completed by the Town Engineering Consultant, Barton & Loguidice,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Fallsburg Town Board proposes to act as Lead Agency in the coordinated review of the Town of Fallsburg/Hamlet of Mountaindale WWTP Project and shall distribute the attached Notice of Intent, Part I of the EAF, and project description and map to all potentially involved and interested agencies.

**WHEREAS, CONGREGATION KAHAL MINCHAS CHINUCH** has instituted proceedings under Article 7 of the Real Property Tax Law to review the assessment of Tax Map Parcels Section 60, Block 1, Lot 51, Parcel 60-1-52, 60-1-53, and 60-1-54 (Willow Heights Road and River Road, Fallsburg, New York 12779); and which proceeding is pending in the Supreme Court of the State of New York, County of Sullivan, Under Index No. 2016-1264; and

**WHEREAS,** the parties herein have appeared through counsel, to wit, Bruce Perlmutter, Esq., on behalf of Respondent, and Terry Forman, Esq., on behalf of Petitioner; and

**WHEREAS,** negotiations by and between the parties hereto have produced a proposed settlement of the issues and matters in dispute, and

**WHEREAS,** the proposed settlement shall result in a fair and equitable resolution of the complaint with respect to petitioner's 2016 assessment, to wit an exemption of 50% in the assessment of petitioner's real property, SBL 60-1-51 to \$40,450 from \$80,900, SBL 60-1-52, to \$3,400 from \$6,800, SBL 60-1-53, to \$6,150 from \$12,300, and SBL 60-1-54 to \$75,000 from \$150,000.

This is to update my April 8, 2018 e-mail regarding my ongoing issues with a town employee. I told you then that I would let you know about the unending, repetitive pattern of Bully behavior. In May, and now in June, my neighbor, and your employee, compulsively stares up 25 feet to my window seat, where I read, talk on the phone and watch television. This happens whenever he is outside, walking up his driveway, either from his car, or walking his dogs. He then loudly yells unintelligible, and most likely unkind words, up at my closed window. I am unable to discern, nor do I care, what he continually repeats. In fact, on June 4, his wife was present for one of his outbursts; I continue to smile at this infantile behavior.

Monthly, different incidents, by both husband and wife, force me to leave my complaint to the Human Rights Commission open, due to this obsession and hatred towards me. The neighborhood, community, county and Human Rights Commission are all aware, each time, of this compulsive ongoing bully behavior. I would like to e-mail you some day and tell you this has all finally stopped as the more I get bullied, the more I speak up.

Adult Bullying is as serious as that of Bullying Children, with potentially dire consequences. At work, there can often be a double standard and some employees seem to avoid consequences. With regard to the Bullying issue, I notice, in your Employees' Code of Ethics Handbook, there is no mention of the words BULLY and HARASSMENT to protect all employees. Looking forward to your addressing this serious issue in the very near future.
