

**By Supervisor Vegliante:** “Thank you all for coming tonight. So far we have been blessed with good weather, hope that continues. The highway department is taking the time to actually catch up on some things and get our equipment in order. While there will be a little snow again this week it looks like it will be warming up by the end of the week. To some that enjoys winter sports I am sure this isn't a welcoming comment. Those that maintain a winter budget it is certainly better than last year so far. We are in the process of looking at some new improvements for our golf course and equipment trying to get certain stuff done, some competitively purchased.”

**Legislator's Report:** **By Ira Steingart:** "When we had our Re-Organization meeting when I first came into the meetings starting Thursday, the new Legislator which I am sure everybody is aware of, we are going to try to work together very nicely and move the county in the right direction. It is definitely a change of position which everybody is aware of. "

**By Supervisor Vegliante:**" Having witnessed the use of that sidewalk really thrilled that we were able to get that grant money to put that in. It really made a huge difference with safety on Laurel Park Road. The Yeshiva has grown formerly the Pines Country Estates and attached to the Pines. It has become a basically an off shoot housing for the Yeshiva. That stretch of road was becoming very dangerous. Thankful to Aileen Gunther and John Bonacic for their assistance they provided and to the State for getting us that money. It has really made it a safer road."

**Citizens' Comment:** **Zack Steingart:** "Are they going to turn on the lights now, there are traffic lights?"

**Supervisor Vegliante:**" I think they are on now. That isn't exactly Steingart. It is just a crossing light."

**Ocean Gilles:**" I wanted to know from you guys when they are going to be fully finished with the new building in Hurleyville, the dance studio. That is going to be affiliated with the Discovery."

**Supervisor Vegliante:** "The Center for Discovery owns that building I know that they are probably 80% done. I actually got a tour there not too long ago. I don't know when they will officially open it. It is a great facility and it will be used by the community often. Between that and the Maker's Lab they really made quite an improvement to our town especially the Hamlet of Hurleyville, absolutely beautiful."

**Albert Braun:** "In regard to the summer drivers, I would like to see a program put together to explain to them to train them to do something about when they come here, they should have a different outlook on how they drive."

**Supervisor Vegliante:**" Funny I have this conversation often with religious and non- religious people. I think the biggest problem we have is you take a bunch of drivers that are very used to driving in NYC which is a completely different element and that is the big part of the problem. I have racked my brain of thinking of ways to get the message out. We have tried different ways we have getting liaisons in the past. I will say if you have ideas that you would like us to dwell in I am sure the Police Department would like to explore. We are going to work on things that are in our control traffic lights and keep

traffic moving. You are absolutely right if there is a program that you can think of, I haven't found any. If there is an established program or a program we can start and a way to get people to participate we are happy to listen."




